Railway Line: Roma - Lido di Ostia

The line of "Lido" links the station Roma Porta San Paolo (close to Ostiense Station) to the town of Ostia also serving the neighborhoods of Vitinia, Acilia, Casal Bernocchi, Centro Giano and Ostia Antica.

Railway Line: Leonardo Express

From Fiumicino airport to the center of Rome without intermediate stops.

6 to 23 each day the service includes a train every half hour in both directions; the travel time is about 30 minutes. The Leonardo Express trains are fitted with air conditioning and ample space for the guests. From Termini Station trains arrive and depart every hour from binary 25.
